Great New Product

The Ohio Willow Wood company has just introduced a new suspension liner called the **Alpha Select Liner**.

This new liner offers several improvements over previously available suspension liners.

✍ The gel has been reinforced with Kevlar pulp to increase durability.

✍ The outer fabric on the front has been changed to improve stretch & comfort over the knee.

✍ The fabric on the sides and back have been changed to limit the stretch and reduce the vertical movement associated with liners which have too much top to bottom stretch.

✍ The gel pattern has been changed to increase the amount of cushioning at the bottom.

The "Pecos Bill"?

Starting July 6th Medicare will begin implementing a new regulation that requires all referring physicians to be enrolled in Medicare through the **Provider Enrollment, Chain and Ownership System (PECOS)** in order to be eligible to refer their Medicare patients for prosthetic and other services. This regulation was to go into effect on January 3, 2011, but with the passage of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA), the deadline to enroll in PECOS has been moved up to July 6, 2010. Some physicians were either unaware of this regulation or thought they had plenty of time to enroll. This change in deadline, however, has changed all that.

What does this mean to you? Starting July 6th when you call to make an appointment with us we will be asking you questions about your insurance coverage and your prescribing physician. If we determine that you are a Medicare recipient and your physician is not enrolled in PECOS, we will direct you to get your prescription from another physician that is enrolled. If you get a prescription from a non-enrolled physician we cannot file your claim with it. Do not assume that just because your physician accepts Medicare for you that he is enrolled in PECOS. It only takes a minute for us to check to see whether or not they are enrolled. Please call us if you need to see if your doctor is enrolled or if you have any questions or concerns.

When was your prosthesis last inspected?

Like a car or any other mechanical device, a prosthesis can wear out. It needs to be checked regularly for signs of wear and any possible risk of failure. A prosthesis should be inspected **at least once a year** to make sure it is safe and to perform maintenance needed to extend its' useful life.



We recommend a six month inspection interval. If your prosthesis has not been checked within the last year, please call and arrange a free inspection to be safe.

A prescription will be needed in order to file your claim.*

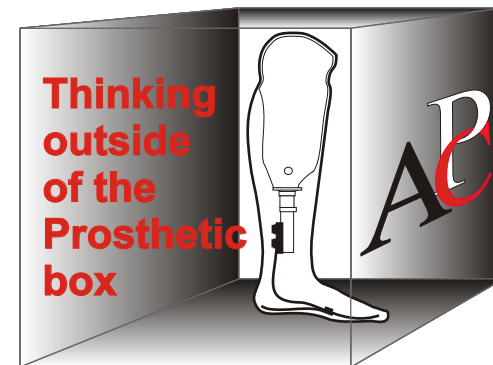
